

Conclusion

- [31] When I consider the entirety of the evidence, I find that Mr. Phan had the experience to purchase items over the Internet using the dark market. He used Bitcoin to do so. It is reasonable to infer that he was also using the dark market to sell his illegal narcotics based upon his knowledge, the quantity of narcotics and the mailing supplies found in his unit. The deposits to his digital wallet were from dark market cites: Evolution and Agora. The only reasonable inference to be drawn from the abovementioned evidence is that the Bitcoins found in the digital wallet on Mr. Phan's computer are the proceeds of crime.
- [32] I am satisfied that Crown Counsel has proven beyond a reasonable doubt that the 281.41 Bitcoins found in the digital wallet on Mr. Phan's computer are the proceeds of crime pursuant to s 462.37(2). As such, I am exercising my discretion to order that 281.41 Bitcoins should be forfeited.
- [33] Although I am suspicious, I am not satisfied beyond a reasonable doubt that the remaining 7.23 Bitcoins are proceeds of crime. Accordingly, 7.23 Bitcoins will not be forfeited.
