CORE FUNCTIONS:

- Produce research on current and emerging issues in the domestic and international environment to inform reforms and forward looking policies in the monetary and financial sectors; formulate policy recommendations for the Governor and senior Central Bank officials.
- Provide input to maintain constructive policy dialogue and engagement with domestic and external stakeholders inter-alia, the local private and public sectors, regional and international organisations / forums.
- Monitor and anticipate external trends affecting the core functions of the Central Bank.

EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS:

- Master's degree in economics, law, finance or related policy research area from a recognised tertiary institution, with three (3) years progressive supervisory experience in policy research or similar experience within a Ministry of Finance, central bank, or international agency.
- Applied knowledge of formal research techniques, including data analysis (statistics/econometrics), documentation of sources and presentation of reports.
- Sound knowledge of the domestic and international financial sectors.
- Sound knowledge of the domestic and regional regulatory frameworks.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Adeptness with spreadsheet/word processing/database software applications.
- Sound project management skills necessary to plan, integrate, and appraise policy motivated work.
- Sound human relations skills required to interact with internal management and staff, participate in internal committees and represent the Central Bank in domestic and international fora.
- Excellent analytical and forecasting skills and sound judgement required to analyse and interpret economic data evaluate and develop policy recommendations.

Note: After a 2- to 3-year posting, the Policy Advisor would resume or take up assignment in either Research, Bank Supervision or Exchange Control Department. Equivalent or lateral posts would be Economist (Research), or Assistant Manager, Policy Unit (Bank Supervision) or Assistant Manager (Exchange Control)
