Security Council ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee Amends Two Entries on Its Sanctions List

Pursuant to Section 3A of the International Obligations (Economic & Ancillary Measures) Amendment Act, 2019, and Resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011), and 2253 (2015) concerning ISIL (Da'esh), Al-Qaida and associated individuals, groups, undertakings, and entities, supervised financial institutions ("SFIs") are hereby informed that the Security Council ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee has updated its Sanctions List as follows:

Request for Information

In accordance with the GFSR Targeted Financial Sanctions Reporting Forms Guidance Notes, the Central Bank of The Bahamas ("the Central Bank") hereby requires all SFIs licensed in The Bahamas to, as a matter of high priority, review their client records to determine whether or not they hold funds, other financial assets or economic resources that are owned or controlled directly or indirectly by persons or entities listed on the Sanctions List, or by any person acting on their behalf or at their discretion, and to report only positive findings to the Central Bank. Additionally, any positive findings ("hits") are required to be reported to the Financial Intelligence Unit and the Attorney General.

NIL reporting is not required.
